**Subject:** feedback on do-not-call Personal Data Protection Bill

it is a good news for people to know the "Personal Data Protection Bill". However, beside normal marketing firm, I think [redacted] should also be included.

Currently, [redacted] collect personal data from local teleco and post on [redacted]. People can find a person's contact and address by simply search one's name on the website.

When contacting [redacted], they clarified they are "authorized" to disclose such personal information. It is because when we sign up a landline with local teleco, (e.g. Singtel, Starhub, M1) by default, we need to agree on their "term and condition", which requires us to allow them to pass our personal info to [redacted]. If we do not agree, we either have to "pay to remove" or we can not use their service.

**This is really a 霸王条款!**

I approached GRC parliament to seek help. Mr Wong Kan Seng wrote to [redacted] to make the request. However, they just simply rejected in a very unfriendly manner.

I hope the upcoming "Personal Data Protection Bill" can also consider above-mentioned issue.
