Subject: Invasion of Privacy

Dear Sirs

This is an example in which organizers obtain personal particulars (mandatory fields) from registrants for participation, goodie bag and bonus draw:

The fine prints at the end of the registration read as follows:

"N.B. By taking part in the bonus draw, entrants agree that the Organiser, their parent companies, affiliates, subsidiaries, satellite providers, events, advertising and promotion agencies, and their respective officers, directors, and employees shall not be liable for injury, loss or damage of any kind resulting from participation in this draw or from the acceptance or use/misuse of the prize awarded. This includes, without limitation, personal injury, death, property damage and claims based on **publicity rights**, defamation, or **invasion of privacy**."

The law should not allow such disclaimer as it gives organizers all rights to 'abuse' the data disclosed by participants!
