Subject: Feedback on Personal Data Protection Bill-Consultation Paper

Referenced is made to the consultation paper on Personal Data Protection Bill.

I like to raise a point with regards to personal data collected and maintained by MCST (Management Corporation Strata Title) for private condominiums.

It is common practice for MCST to publish sole proprietors and office bearers names and address on notice boards and also by hard copy circulation during general meetings.

I wonder how is the PDPB bill will co-exist with the Land Strata Titles Act which may require a certain level of disclosure for the management of strata title property.

For example a list of sole proprietors with unit numbers and addresses of a condominium, published for the AGM, may be used by a housing agent, sales promotion company etc.

There should not be a too onerous application of such laws to MCST that will increase cost, and at the same time MCST need to manage and secure private data properly.
