Dear Sirs

With reference to the abovementioned public consultation, we would like to seek clarification as to whether the proposed Bill would apply to information collected by banks as part of usual banking practice although it may not be specifically required by law. In particular, it is usual banking practice for banks to request that the directors/office holders of a corporate customer furnish their ID documents for account opening, although there is no specific law we are aware of requiring that such ID documents be collected for account opening purposes.

We would suggest such information be treated as business contact information to the extent collected and used for banking control purposes.
