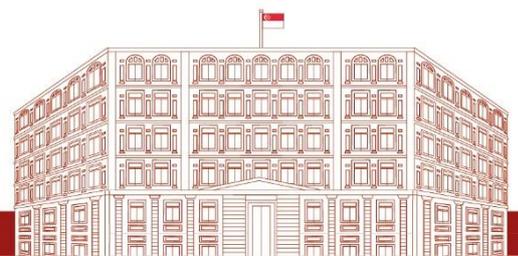
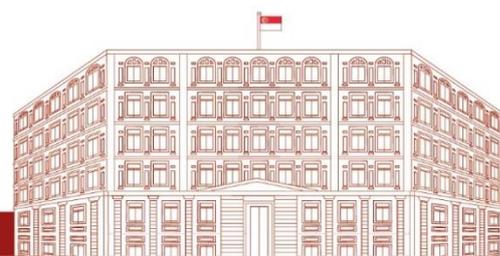

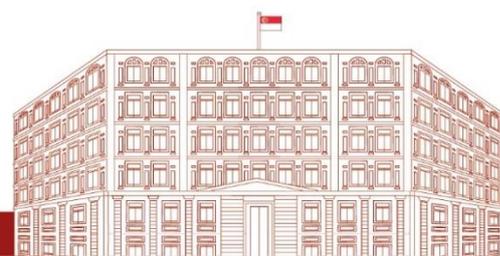

A	General Questions on Translation Talent Development Scheme
1	<p>What is the Translation Talent Development Scheme (TTDS)?</p> <p>The Translation Talent Development Scheme (TTDS) is a co-sponsorship grant to support Singaporean translation and interpretation (T&I) practitioners from the private sector to further develop their capabilities and attain mastery of their skills.</p> <p>If you are awarded, you will receive a grant of up to S\$10,000. You can use this grant to offset 90 per cent of the expenses incurred in your participation of capability development programme(s).</p>
2	<p>What can I use TTDS for?</p> <p>TTDS can be used for the following categories of capability development programme(s) related to translation, interpretation and/or languages in Singapore and overseas:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a. short courses, workshops and intensive summer courses; b. courses that lead to a full qualification (e.g. Diploma, Bachelor's degree, Postgraduate diploma, Master's degree); c. conferences and seminars; and d. certification examinations. <p>For examples of suitable programmes, please refer to Question 7. You may also propose to attend multiple programmes (refer to Question 8).</p>
3	<p>Do I need to serve a bond?</p> <p>Recipients are not required to serve any bond, but will be appointed as National Translation Committee (NTC) Ambassadors for the period of one year. They will be required to conduct sharing sessions or workshops as part of the Community-in-Translation initiative and/or contribute their expertise for other NTC initiatives.</p>



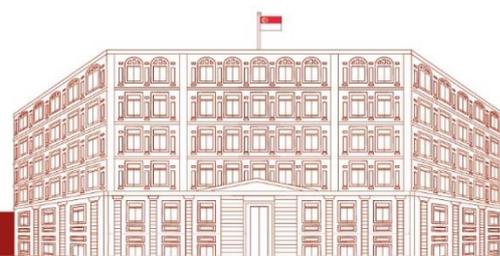

B	Questions on Eligibility Criteria															
5	<p data-bbox="263 1272 983 1301">Who can apply for TTDS? What are the eligibility criteria?</p> <p data-bbox="263 1339 1430 1464">TTDS is open to Singaporean T&I practitioners from the private sector with at least three years of combined experience in translation and/or interpretation and with good work performance. Applicants must also be working in the following language pairs: English and Chinese, English and Malay, <u>or</u> English and Tamil.</p> <p data-bbox="263 1503 1430 1570">Additionally, applicants must not have received any scholarships and/or sponsorships from the Government (except MOE tuition fee grants) for their same chosen programme(s).</p> <p data-bbox="263 1608 1430 1765">For applicants who have additional sources of funding from other organisations, the total grant amount including from the Ministry of Communications and Information (MCI) will be capped at the programme's fees. For example, if the course fees amount to S\$20,000 and the applicant has received a S\$15,000 grant from a private organisation, the grant disbursed under TTDS will be capped at S\$5,000.</p>															
6	<p data-bbox="263 1809 823 1839">I am a Public Officer. Am I eligible for TTDS?</p> <p data-bbox="263 1877 1430 1944">TTDS is only open to Singaporean T&I practitioners from the <u>private sector</u> with at least three years of combined experience in translation and/or interpretation.</p>

C	Questions on Supported Programmes
7	<p>What capability development programmes are eligible for TTDS?</p> <p>Programmes of a duration of up to one year must start or end within 1 April of the application year and 31 March of the following year to be eligible, i.e. they can start/end between or on these two dates. E.g. For an application submitted in 2020, the programme(s) must fall within 1 April 2020 and 31 March 2021.</p> <p>Programmes that stretch more than one year (e.g. degree and postgraduate courses) must end by 31 March within 3 years of the application. E.g. For an application submitted in 2020, the programme must end by 31 March 2023.</p> <p>Examples of suitable programmes include programmes on general translation/interpretation, specialised translation such as audio-visual translation, legal translation, business and financial translation, specialised interpretation such as conference interpreting, translation technology (e.g. computer-assisted translation and machine translation) and applied linguistics.</p>
8	<p>Can I participate in multiple capability development programmes?</p> <p>Yes, so long as these programmes have been proposed in your application, they are within the period of eligibility (refer to Question 7) and can be covered by the grant.</p>
9	<p>The capability development programme I intend to take is not yet open for registration. Can I still apply for TTDS?</p> <p>You may still submit your TTDS application before the deadline. However, please indicate this in your application form and provide proof that you are awaiting invitation to the programme, e.g. email correspondences with the programme provider confirming that registration will open at a later date. If necessary, the NTC Secretariat will seek further verification with you on the status of your programme registration.</p>
D	Questions on Application Process
10	<p>When can I apply for TTDS?</p> <p>TTDS is open for application from 1 April to 31 May 2020 (both dates inclusive).</p> <p>Applications can be made at the TTDS website at www.mci.gov.sg/ttds. All applications must reach the NTC Secretariat by 2359hrs Singapore time on 31 May 2020. Applications received after this closing date and time shall be disqualified.</p> <p>The NTC Secretariat reserves the right to disqualify applicants who fail to complete any forms and/or provide any documents required in their application.</p>

12	<p>The programme that I have applied for was cancelled. What should I do?</p> <p>Please inform the NTC Secretariat at MCI_NTC_Secretariat@mci.gov.sg as soon as possible. You will be allowed to find a replacement programme within a reasonable period of time.</p>									
13	<p>Can I postpone the completion of a programme to a later date?</p> <p>Recipients who require a longer period of time to complete their programme(s) may write in to the NTC Secretariat to request for approval.</p>									
14	<p>What happens if I fail to complete a programme due to reasons <u>not</u> stated in Question 12 and 13, e.g. terminated from studies?</p> <p>Recipients will have to return any previously disbursed funds for the particular programme.</p>									
15	<p>Can I receive the TTDS grant more than once?</p> <p>No. You are only allowed to receive the grant once. This is to allow more Singaporean translation and interpretation practitioners to benefit from the Scheme.</p>									
16	<p>Can I apply for the TTDS grant more than once?</p> <p>Yes, provided that you fulfil the eligibility criteria for the TTDS. Please note that you are only allowed to receive the grant once.</p>
