



Annex A: Factsheet on MOUs between NLB and the Turkish National Library, and the Directorate of State Archives of the Presidency of the Republic of Turkey

MOU between National Library Board and the Turkish National Library

The National Library Board and the Turkish National Library signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) in Ankara, Turkey on 3 April 2019. The MOU provides for the following areas of potential collaboration:

- Sharing knowledge on library and archives materials that relate to the history, culture or heritage of Singapore and Turkey or other countries that are within research interests. This could include sharing of catalogue information, access initiatives and possible digitisation initiatives.
- Professional exchanges that cover subjects such as administration, collection development and management, conservation and preservation, curatorship, exhibition design, information technology and outreach programmes.

MOU between the National Archives of Singapore and the Directorate of State Archives of the Presidency of the Republic of Turkey

Prior to Minister Iswaran's visit to Turkey, the National Archives of Singapore (an institution of the National Library Board) and the Directorate of State Archives of the Presidency of the Republic of Turkey concluded an MOU on 26 February 2019. The MOU provides for the following areas of potential collaboration:

- Conducting research on subjects of interest such as the history, culture or cultural heritage of both countries. Professional exchanges of reproduced samples of archival documents as well as any guides, inventories and similar research tools.
- Exchange of knowledge in the field of archives in order to share expertise on issues such as electronic and modern technologies and restoration activities.
- Organise scientific meetings and exhibitions on archives.
